**CHARLESTOWN LIMITS ACT**

AN ACT TO DEFINE THE LIMITS OF CHARLESTOWN.

**Short title.**

1. This Act may be cited as the Charlestown Limits Act.

**Limits of the town defined.**

2. The limits of the town of Charlestown in the island of Nevis shall be deemed and taken to be as follows:

From the sea at the boundary of Pinneys Estate and the Nevis Club property then going in an Easterly direction along the main Public Road to the road leading up to Craddock Road then going South to the Big Rock at the corner of Craddock Road then in a straight line to the public water supply tank at the corner of Government and Roger Below roads then along the Public Road to the Cemetery corner on the main Public Road, then Westward along the main Public Road continuing along the road South of Government House and the Bath Hotel to the sea.
