WESLEYAN METHODIST (VESTING OF PROPERTY) ACT

AN ACT TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE VESTING OF REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE WESLEYAN METHODIST MISSIONARY TRUST ASSOCIATION.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Wesleyan Methodist (Vesting of Property) Act.

Vesting of property.

2. All real and personal property in the State now held or vested in the Wesleyan Methodist Missionary Society or held by or vested in the people called Wesleyan Methodists or held by or vested in any person or persons on behalf of the said Society or the said Wesleyan Methodists shall be held by and vested in the Wesleyan Methodist Missionary Trust Association, its successors and assigns for the same estates and interests and to the extent which the same were respectively at the time of the passing of this Act held or vested as aforesaid subject to the rights, reservations and charges (if any) now affecting the same and the trusts upon which the same are now held.

Saving of rights.

3. Nothing in this Act shall prejudice or affect the rights of Her Majesty the Queen, Her Heirs and Successors or any body politic or corporate or of any other person or persons except such as are mentioned in this Act and those claiming by, from, through or under them.
